

## COOKIE POLICY

This Policy applies to the following website owned by UNÍSONO SOLUTIONS GROUP, S.L. belonging to the Intelcia Group [www.grupounisono.es/](http://www.grupounisono.es/) (hereinafter the "Website").

When you access the Website, we will show you a cookie notice informing you how you can give consent or refuse or configure the use of cookies through a configuration panel (hereinafter, "Configuration Panel"). [You can also access this panel to modify your settings at any time via the link https://www.grupounisono.es/](https://www.grupounisono.es/)

The Website uses automatic data collection procedures (Cookies) to collect personal information, such as the type of browser or operating system, referring page, path, ISP (Internet Service Provider) domain, etc., all in order to improve the services provided. Cookies help us to tailor the Website to your personal needs.

A "Cookie" is a small file that is stored on your device and allows us to recognise you. The set of "cookies" helps us to improve the quality of the Website, thus allowing us to personalise each user's navigation of the Website to a certain extent. Cookies are now essential to the functioning of the Internet, providing countless advantages in the provision of interactive services, facilitating the navigation and usability of the Website.

Please note that cookies cannot damage your computer and that, in return, the fact that they are activated helps us to identify and resolve errors and improve the navigability of the Website.

### Types of cookies:

For further information for the user on the typology and use of cookies, we inform you that:

- From the point of view of **'lifetime' of the cookie** (time that the cookie remains active on our equipment) we can differentiate cookies between:
    1. **Session cookies:** these are temporary cookies that remain in the cookie file of your browser until you leave the website, so that none is recorded on the user's hard drive. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyse web traffic patterns. In the long run, this allows us to provide a better experience to improve the content and facilitate its use.
    2. **Persistent cookies:** these are stored on your hard drive and are read by the website each time you make a return visit. A persistent cookie has a set expiry date. The cookie will stop working after that date. We generally use them to facilitate the user's experience by remembering their browsing habits or, where appropriate, to facilitate the purchase and/or registration services.
  - From the point of view of the **purpose of each cookie**, we can differentiate between:
    1. **Technical Cookies:** these are those that allow the user to browse through a website, platform or application and the use of the different options or services that exist therein, including those that the editor uses to enable the management and operation of the website and enable its functions and services.
    2. **Technical cookies, provided that they are strictly necessary for the operation of the website, do not require consent for their installation. Preference or personalisation cookies:** these are cookies that enable information to be remembered so that the user can access the service with certain characteristics that may differentiate their experience from that of other users, such as, for example, the language, the number of results to be shown when the user performs a search, the appearance or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses the service or the region from which they access the service, etc.
- If it is the user himself who chooses these characteristics (for example, if he selects the language of a website by clicking on the icon of the flag of the corresponding country), it will not be necessary for the user to have consented to the installation of these cookies through the Configuration Panel.
3. **Analysis or measurement cookies:** these are cookies that allow the party responsible for them to monitor and analyse the behaviour of the users of the websites to which they are linked, including the quantification of the impact of advertisements. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the usage data of the users of the service.
  4. **Behavioural advertising cookies:** these are cookies that store information on the behaviour of users obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows a specific profile to be developed in order to display advertising based on this.
- Finally, from the point of view of the **entity that manages the cookies**, we can differentiate between:
    1. **Own cookies:** these are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

2. **Third-party cookies:** those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.

#### Techniques

Necessary cookies are absolutely essential for the Website to function correctly. This category only includes cookies that ensure basic functionalities and security features of the Website.

Usually a randomly generated number, the way it is used can be site specific, but a good example is to maintain a login state for a user between pages.	Permanent cookie
jnytkcc	grupounisono.es	2 hours	Cookie used to secure the submission of forms to avoid Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) attacks.	Permanent cookie

#### Analytical

These cookies allow the party responsible for them to monitor and analyse the behaviour of the users of the web pages to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the Website and to create user browsing profiles, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the data on the use made by users of the service.

_ga	Google	2 years	Analytical cookies (Google Analytics): Uses an anonymous identifier to distinguish anonymous users and perform analysis on user interactions in the application in order to optimise the services offered.	Permanent cookie

_gat	Google	1 minute	Used to limit the percentage of requests.	Permanent cookie
_gcl_au	Google	3 months	Used by Google AdSense to experiment with advertising efficiency on websites using its services.	Permanent cookie

## Advertising

These are cookies that store information on user behaviour obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows a specific profile to be developed in order to display advertising based on the same. These cookies obtain information about the user's browsing habits in order to manage advertising spaces and offer more relevant and quality content to the user based on an analysis of their tastes and preferences.

IDE	doubleclick.net	1 year	Used to improve advertising. It is often used to target advertising to content that is relevant to a user, improve campaign performance reporting and avoid showing ads that the user has already seen. VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	youtube.com	6 months	Keeps track of visited videos that are embedded in the website	Permanent cookie
YSC	youtube.com	Session	Measures video views made by the user and records "Like" or "Share" events.	Permanent cookie

## Preferences or Customisation

These are those that allow information to be remembered so that the user can access the service with certain characteristics that may differentiate their experience from that of other users, such as, for example, the language, the number of results to be displayed when the user performs a search, the appearance or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses the service or the region from which the user accesses the service, etc.

Intelcia stores all information collected through Cookies in a non-personalised format (IP address). This type of information obtained through cookies will not be disclosed outside Intelcia except in those cases indicated in the section 'List and description of cookies', or used for unsolicited communications.
